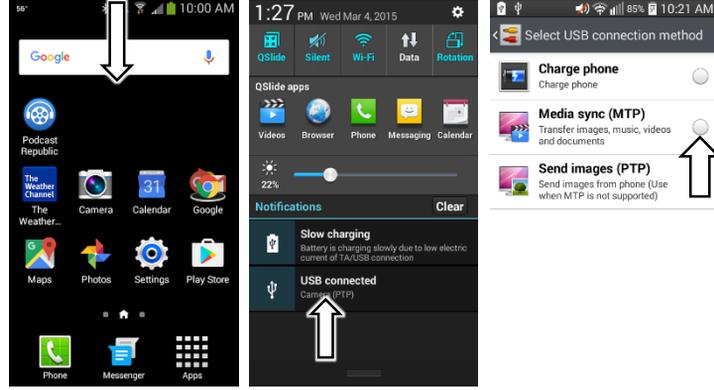


Transfer photos from your device to your computer - Windows 10

1. Plug device into the computer

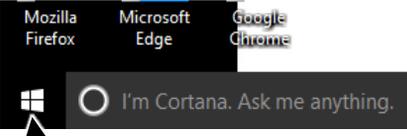


2. For Android devices - on your device, swipe down from the top and select USB option

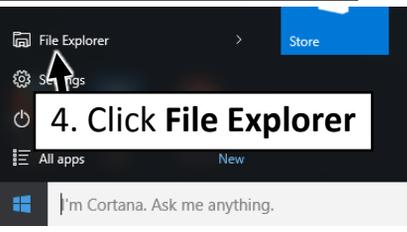


On your Windows 10 computer:

4. Click File Explorer

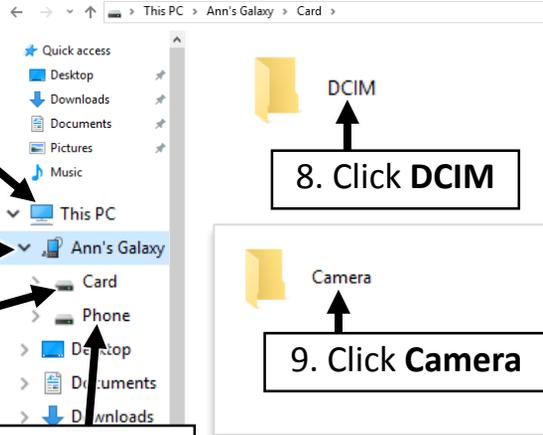
On the left of window

6. Click the name of your device

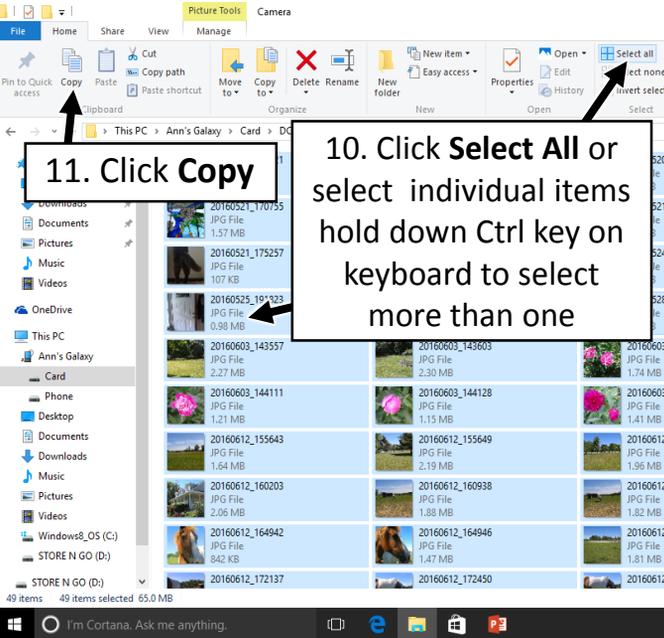
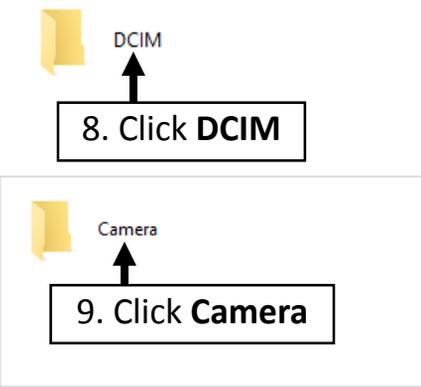
7. If you added a micro SD card, click on Card

7. Or with no card, click on your device name, then **Internal Storage** if needed



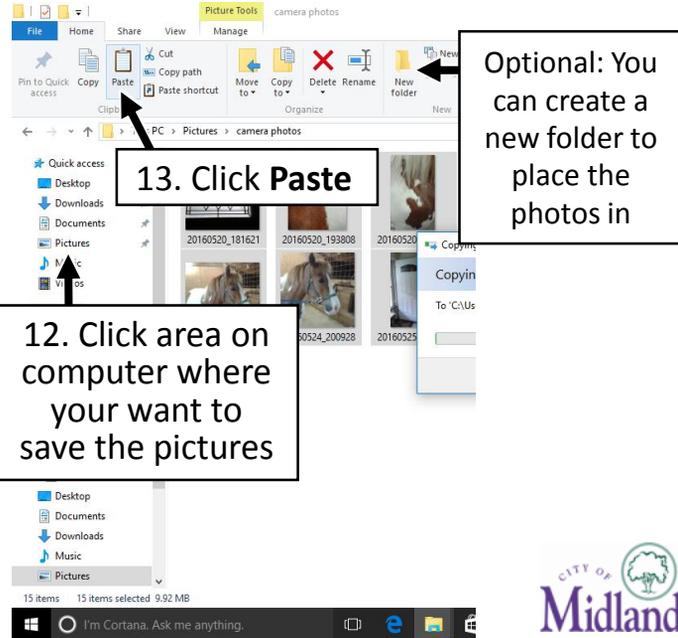
8. Click DCIM

12. Click area on computer where you want to save the pictures

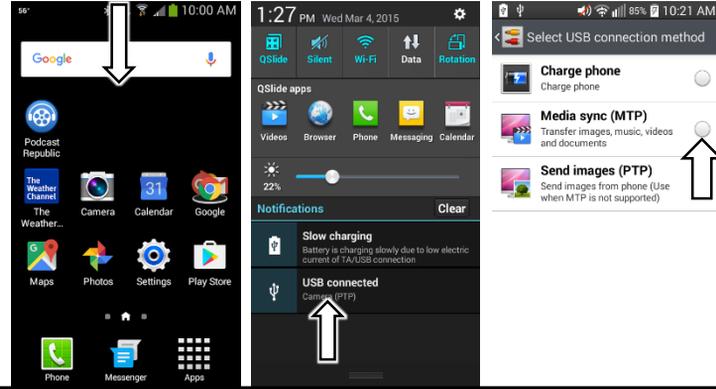

Differences in other Computer Versions:

Windows: Your android device will appear in the Computer or My Computer folder

Windows XP : Install Windows Media Player 11 to transfer.

Windows 8: Press the Windows Key on your keyboard, then folders icon on the taskbar at the bottom.

Mac: You will need to install Android File Transfer to complete the USB transfer. <http://www.android.com/filetransfer>. Your android will appear on the desktop.
