Rot and Ruin (2010)

In a post-apocalyptic world where fences and border patrols guard the few people left from the zombies, Benny Imura finally decides he must become a bounty hunter like his brother.

McBride, Lish

Hold Me Closer, Necromancer (2010)

Sam discovers that he is a necromancer, part of a world of harbingers, werewolves, satyrs, and another necromancer that sees Sam as a threat to his lucrative business of raising the dead.

- Oppel, Kenneth** *This Dark Endeavor: The Apprenticeship of Victor Frankenstein* (2011)
When his twin brother falls ill, Victor embarks on a dangerous quest to create the forbidden Elixir of Life described in an ancient text in the family's secret Bibliotheka Obscura.
- Peacock, Kathleen** *Hemlock* (2012)
Mackenzie attempts to solve the mystery of her best friend's murder in a town affected by the werewolf virus.
- Ryan, Carrie** *The Forest of Hands and Teeth* (2009)
Orphaned Mary wants to know what lies beyond her walled village and the surrounding forest, where dwell the unconsecrated, aggressive, flesh-eating people who were once dead.
- St. Crow, Lili** *Strange Angels* (2009)
Dru's psychic abilities helped her father battle zombies and other creatures, but now she needs help from her "werwulf"-bitten friend and a vampire hunter to learn who killed her parents.
- Shan, Darren** *Cirque Du Freak: The Saga of Darren Shan* (2001-2006)
A series dripping with vampires, that begins with two teenage boys at an illegal freak show. Their encounter with a vampire and a deadly spider forces them to make life-changing choices.
- Shusterman, Neal** *Darkness Creeping: Twenty Twisted Tales* (2007)
Take a walk on the dark side with this collection of delightfully creepy short stories.
- Smith, L. J.** *Night World* (1996-97)
Nine books make up this series of vampires, werewolves, witches, and shapeshifters. Night World is their secret society with very strict rules and falling in love breaks all the laws.
- Stoker, Bram** *Dracula* (1897)
The original classic blood-chilling vampire tale of the Count from Transylvania.
- Waters, Daniel** *Generation Dead* (2008)
When dead teens who have come back to life start showing up at her high school, Phoebe starts dating a "living impaired" boy and together they encounter prejudice, fear, and hatred.
- Wooding, Chris** *The Haunting of Atlaizabel Cray* (2004)
In a gothic-style London straight from Jack the Ripper, Thaniel Fox hunts creatures of the night with his mentor, Catherine, in this story that will appeal to fantasy and horror fans alike.
- Yancey, Rick** *Monstrumologist* (2009)
In 1888, Will Henry chronicles his apprenticeship with Dr. Warthrop, a scientist who hunts and studies real-life monsters, as they discover and attempt to destroy a pod of Anthropophagi.
- Yovanoff, Brenna** *The Replacement* (2010)
Mackie knows that he replaced a human child when he was just an infant. When a friend's sister disappears he decides he has to confront the beings that dwell under the town.
